



WILLIAM JEZEK MEMORIAL PRESERVE

The preserve includes 18.5 acres and another 28-acre easement along the shoreline of the Moodus Reservoir. The preserve has frontage on Daniel Peck and Beebe Roads, and a long stretch reaches to the reservoir. The land hosts a moderate-age oak/beech/maple forest with several wetlands, a small brook that flows into the reservoir, stone walls, and steep slopes.

A trail accessed on Daniel Peck Road descends through the preserve to Beebe Road.
