

## SHEEPSKIN HOLLOW PRESERVE

### Directions:

#### Option 1

- \* From Route 82, take Mt. Parnassus Rd. east about 3 miles.
- \* Turn right on Sheepskin Hollow Rd.
- \* Continue past the Pet Kennel to find the small dirt parking area on the left.

#### Option 2

- \* From Route 82, take Mt. Parnassus Rd east about 3 1/2 miles.
- \* Turn right on Warner Rd.
- \* Turn right on Ridgebury Rd.
- \* Park in the cul-de-sac. The trailhead is facing south, marked by white blazes, between the last two houses in the cul-de-sac.

#### Option 3

- \* From Route 82, take Mt. Parnassus Rd east about 3 1/2 miles.
- \* Turn right on Warner Rd.
- \* Turn right on A.P.Gates Rd.
- \* Turn right on Woodmont Circle.
- \* The trailhead is on the right, marked by the yellow blazes.

### TRAIL FACTS:

- ◇ The 1.2 mile white trail has some long, moderate elevations and leads close to the pond.
- ◇ The .4 mile yellow trail is accessed from the white trail or from Woodmont Circle.
- ◇ The .46 mile red trail is accessed from the white or yellow trail. It is fairly flat terrain through the forested areas of the preserve.
- ◇ The .48 blue trail is accessed from the yellow trail or from the Sheepskin Hollow Rd parking area. It takes you over some waterways and to a lovely seasonal waterfall.
- ◇ The .24 mile purple trail connects the blue and red trails.
- ◇ The .07 mile orange trail connects the yellow and blue trails.


## EAST HADDAM TRAILS

### SHEEPSKIN HOLLOW PRESERVE

The 119-acre East Haddam Land Trust property offers a number of walking trails with small waterfalls and rock formations. Various wildlife reside here, such as barred owls, wild turkeys, many hawks, and deer. Along the pond and waterways, beaver, mink, weasels and muskrats can be seen. Some of the trails provide excellent views of Sheepskin Hollow Pond. A large beaver dam is at the south end of the pond. The property encompasses a ravine and mixed woods.
